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The Project

ETEE aims to improve significantly Enterprise Educators provision delivered within the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs), the Vocational Education and Training (VET) providers and the enterprise support organisations across Europe, by providing a **practical 'real world' entrepreneurial experience**.

To achieve this, partners will design, build and test the ETEE Training Programme, with the close engagement of stakeholders and potential beneficiaries, to achieve a need driven solution. Multipliers events are organized alongside the project to guarantee the reach out and impact of the products delivered.

Entrepreneurial Training for Enterprise Educators - ETEE is a 2-year project co-funded by the Erasmus+ Program of the European Union.

Objectives

Partners will dedicate to **design and develop a training programme for enterprise educators**: those people who have the greatest influence and responsibility in the design and delivery of enterprise provision, the academic staff who embed enterprise in their teaching, and professional service staff who deliver extra-curricular activities.
