ABOUT ETEE

We created the ETEE course to provide a novel training approach for enterprise educators. This course will offer entrepreneurial experience through the lens of an enterprise educator and the system in which they work. Our belief is that those who carry the responsibility for the development of enterprise skills and mindsets will benefit from the opportunity to experience entrepreneurial thinking themselves first hand, in a context relevant for what they do every day.

THE PURPOSE

of this training is to support you to embed enterprise education within programme, curricular and classroom activities, and enhance your own entrepreneurial experience. The outline below gives you an overview of our proposed course structure, approach and content. We hope it will also create the appetite to hear more from us and become involved in our network.

THE PARTICIPANT

will experience an entrepreneurial and creative approach to their own programme design. Your role will be to design, develop and deliver a learning programme that will enhance your entrepreneurial skills and therefore those of your students.

THE PROCESS



There are three stages divided into nine two-hour modules that include entrepreneurial activities, group exercises and practical content, with ample space and time to reflect on the journey you are taking and the impact you want it to have on your own development/practice.
